NEW STUDENT 7-12 APPLICATION PROCEDURES

The application process for Treasure Valley Christian School is to be completed according to the steps below

1. Complete and return all attached forms including: Articles of Faith, Student Information/Commitment, Parental Agreement, and *reference forms (total of 3) to Treasure Valley's Administration Office.
2. Include the following information with this application:
Grades 7-9A copy of student's most recent report card
Grades 10-12.....A copy of student's transcript showing all classes taken at high school level
Grades 7-12.....A copy of standardized test scores
3. Please note that a completed application is not a guarantee of admission, but only a request for admission.
4. Secondary Only (Grade 7-12): Arrange for reference forms to be completed and sent directly to Treasure Valley Christian School. Reference examples are: 1) Pastor or church leader; 2) personnel from your previous school; and 3) employer or group leader (i.e., Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Boys & Girls Club, etc .). Please send a total of three references.
5. Participate in a personal family interview. An appointment for this interview will be scheduled once the application is complete. The student, with a least one parent, will participate in the interview.
6. Schedule an appointment for placement.
7. Complete the registration process after the student is notified of acceptance. The payment of Registration Fees will reserve the student's placement at the school. The student is not enrolled until the Comprehensive Registration Fees are paid in full.
8. Arrange transfer of previous school records.
9. Please schedule an appointment for Irlen Screening after registration fees are paid.
10. Provide immunization records at time of registration along with a state certified birth certificate.
11. Applicants are enrolled on a space available basis.

12. New applicants for September entrance will be immediately admitted as space is available. For those grade levels with limited space, new students will be accepted from the pool of available candidates, beginning in March, on an optimum student and space available basis.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

1. There is one God, who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (1 Timothy 2:5; 1 Corinthians 12:4-6, II Corinthians 13:14; Ephesians 1:1-14)
2. Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of Virgin Mary. He died upon the cross, the Just for the unjust, as a substitutionary sacrifice, and all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. He rose from the dead according to Scriptures. He is now at the right hand of the Majesty on high as our great High Priest. (Matthew 1:22-23; Luke 1:35; John 1:18; Romans 3:21-26; Hebrews 1:1-3; 1 Peter 3:18)
3. The Holy Spirit is a divine person, sent to indwell, guide, teach, empower the believer, and convince the world of sin, of righteousness and of judgement. (John 13:16-26; 16:5-11)
4. The Old and New Testaments, inerrant as originally given, were verbally inspired by God and are complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men. They constitute the divine and only rule of Christian faith and practice. (Matthew 5:17-20; John 10:35; II Timothy 3:16)
5. Man was originally created in the image and likeness of God; he fell through disobedience, incurring both physical and spiritual death. All men are born with a sinful nature, are separated from the life of God, and can be saved only through the atoning work of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Genesis 1:26-27; John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Romans 1:18-20)
6. Salvation has been provided through Jesus Christ for all men; and those who repent and believe in Him, receiving Him as personal Savior and Lord, are born again of the Holy Spirit, receive the gift of eternal life, and become the children of God. (Acts 2:38f; Romans 3:21-26)
7. The church consists of all those who believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, are redeemed through His blood, and are born again of the Holy Spirit. Christ is the Head of the Body, the Church, which has been commissioned by Him to go into the entire world as a witness, preaching the gospel to all nations. (Matthew 28:18-20; Romans 1:4; 1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 1:22-23)

8. The local church is a body of believers in Christ who are joined together for the local worship of God, for edification through the Word of God, for prayer, fellowship, the proclamation of the gospel, and observance of the ordinances of baptism and the Lord's Supper. (Acts 10:47-48; Luke 22: 17-20; I Corinthians 11:23-32)
9. There shall be a bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust; for the former a resurrection unto life, for the latter, a resurrection unto judgment. (Matthew 25:31-46; Hebrews 9:27)
10. The second coming of the Lord Jesus Christ is imminent and will be personal and visible. This is the vital truth which is an incentive to holy living and faithful service. (acts 1:9-11; Titus 2:13; 1 Peter 3:11)

1. When we say the Old and New Testaments constitute the **only** rule of Christian faith and practice, we specifically mean that we do not accept any other testaments, documents, or revelations claiming similar divine inspiration. We consider any other such claims to be false and heretical.
2. We believe that this salvation process comes by grace, through faith alone. Works of any kind are a result of salvation, not in any way a means to it. (Ephesians 2:8-9)
3. Part of our witness is found in how we respond in society. Civil governments are of divine appointment for the interests and good order of human society. Those in civil authority are to be prayed for and conscientiously honored and obeyed except in things contrary to the Word of God. (Romans 13:1-7; II Samuel 23:3; Exodus 18:21-22; Acts 4:19-20, 5:20, 23:5 Matthew 22:21; Daniel 3:17-18)

It is our desire that the nondenominational position of the school be stressed and maintained. Emphasis is upon unity and basic biblical principles that we share as believers in Christ.

In making this application, I/we affirm our commitment to the policies, procedures and Statement of Faith as outlined in the school handbook.

As relates to Statement of Faith:

- I/we accept Treasure Valley's Christian School's doctrine "in loco parentis" (or in the place of the parents) where the school, home and local church are viewed as in partnership, and the school's primary function is to assist parents in fulfilling their responsibility to "train up a child in the way they are to go," (Proverbs 22:6). I/We understand that in addition to discipline this includes (a) to counsel my child Biblically, and (b) to be counseled Biblically when matters of my child's welfare arise. (Proverbs 13:24; 19:18; 29:15; Ephesians 6:1-2; Hebrews 12:6)
- I/we agree to have our child(ren) taught the doctrines aforementioned and to give encouragement to them as they seek to supplement these in their personal experience. Inasmuch as Treasure Valley Christian School is nondenominational, I/we realize some of the views of the school may differ from ours. I/We agree to support the teachings of the school based upon the Statements of Faith and to cheerfully support the rules and authority in the Spirit of Christ (Hebrews 13:17).
- I/We pledge our fullest cooperation to keep doctrinal controversy, and denominationalism out of the school at all times. (Romans 13:8-10; 1 Corinthians 12:12-14; 13:1-13; Galatians 5:13-15, 25-26; Ephesians 4:1-7).

As Relates to Academics and Student Activities:

- I/We recognize that the Administration has the full responsibility for the placing of my child in the proper grade.

- I/We have made enough investigation to be satisfied with the curriculum, text, equipment, methods and motives of the school.
- I/We give permission for our child(ren) to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises. Although the school desires to provide a safe and enjoyable time for all students, accidents can still happen. I/We understand that there are risks/dangers involved with participation in off-campus trips and their associated activities.
- In consideration of my child(ren) being allowed to participate in these events, I/we assume responsibility for those ordinary and reasonable risks associated with the travel and activities.
- I/We agree to hold harmless Treasure Valley Christian Schools, its affiliated organizations, employees, agents and representatives, including volunteer and other drivers, from any and all claims arising from my child(ren)'s participation.
- This release agreement does not apply to claims of intentional (criminal) misconduct or gross negligence by the school, its employees or volunteers. If such circumstances are proved in a court of law, I/we acknowledge and agree that the school can assume no financial liability beyond its actual liability insure policy in force.
- I/We give the school permission to take appropriate measures for emergency treatment if I/we cannot be reached.
- I/ We give Treasure Valley Christian School the permission to use any scholastic information, athletic information or photos of child(ren) in press releases they or their representatives submit. An example of location that this information may appear is school brochures, school web page, church bulletins, and local newspapers.

As relates to Student Conduct:

- I/we agree to abide by the school's disciplinary policy as stated in the school handbooks. If after reasonable effort has been made to discipline our child(ren) and to assist his/her academic adjustment, he/she does not comply with the standards of the school, I/we agree to withdraw him/her from enrollment.
- I/we recognize that the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not respect its spiritual standards or cooperate in the educational process.
- I/We hereby authorize the school to use such discipline as it considers just and necessary for the good of my child, including detentions and/or suspensions.
- I/We further agree that I/we will cooperate and discipline our child(ren) in the home, as needed. (Proverbs 13:24, 19:18, 22:6, 29:15; Colossians 3:21; Ephesians 6:4.)
- I/We further understand that the standards of the school do not tolerate profanity or obscenity by word or action, disrespect or bullying of other students, or disrespect to school personnel or abuse of building facilities.
- I/We understand that assessments will be made to cover damage to school property (including breakage of windows, abuse of books, etc.).

As relates to Finances:

- While applying to Treasure Valley Christian School, I/we have no outstanding delinquent accounts at another school.
- I/We agree to pay tuition according to the schedule or to other arrangements that shall be made. Your tuition and fees pay for the normal operating expenses which include faculty salaries. I/We understand that report cards may be withheld if required payments are not made or arranged. I/We also understand that if my account is past due, and no arrangements have been made, my child will no longer be able to attend Treasure Valley Christian School.

As relates to Disputes/ Conflict:

- The parties to this agreement understand that as a Christian institution, the school adheres to the Biblical command to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian community in conformity with the Biblical injunctions of 1 Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23-24 and Matthew 18:15-20. Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute arising out of, or related to, this agreement or to any aspect of the school relationship, including any claim or statutory claims, shall be settled by Biblically-based mediation/binding arbitration. When you have questions involving school policies, procedures, or discipline you should contact the person most immediately involved. That person will normally be the student's teacher. If questions remain, you should contact the school principal. If question still remain, you should then contact the chairmen of school board. All persons (parents and teachers) should not share problems with those not directly involved in the chain of communication.
- If resolution of the dispute and reconciliation do not result from such efforts, the matter shall then be submitted to a panel of arbitrators for binding arbitration. The selection of the arbitrators and the arbitration process shall be conducted in a manner similar to the example set by Peacemaker's Ministry.
- The parties agree that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of the school relationship or this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally-binding arbitration decision.
- Each party, regardless of the outcome of the matter, agrees to bear the cost of his/her/its own arbitrator and one-half of the fees and costs of the neutral arbitrator and any other arbitration expenses.
- If our child(ren) should become involved in any trouble with other children in the school, I/we should in **NO CASE** complain to any parent, that is not directly involved in order to squelch all gossip.
